Minutes of Joint Meeting of the Fairfax Water Board and Fairfax County Board of Supervisors
June 2, 2026

At 11:00 a.m. on Tuesday, June 2, 2026, a joint Meeting of the Fairfax Water Board and Fairfax County Board of Supervisors was held in Conference Room 11 at the Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, VA 22030 with the following in attendance:

Chairman McKay welcomed Fairfax Water's Board Members and staff. He also highlighted Ms. Hedges' upcoming retirement and thanked her for her years of service to Fairfax Water and the Fairfax County community. Chairman McKay then introduced Chairman Allin who provided opening remarks and a summary of the meeting agenda. Chairman Allin then turned it over to Ms. Hedges to present an overview of Fairfax Water and current local and regional topics.

Ms. Hedges presented an overview of Fairfax Water's operations, regulatory compliance, capital investments, and long-term water supply planning, emphasizing continued delivery of high-quality drinking water, full compliance with federal standards, proactive PFAS and lead and copper rule management, and significant infrastructure investments to maintain system reliability. The presentation highlighted current drought conditions, climate-driven watershed challenges, the essential role of UOSA effluent in sustaining the Occoquan Reservoir, and the need for coordinated regional planning to address future supply risks.

After the presentation, Ms. Hedges and staff answered questions from Members of the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors. Following discussion, Chairman McKay and Chairman Allin gave closing remarks.

There being no further business, the Meeting was adjourned at 12:32 p.m.
