By mutual agreement, Contract No. 2019-068 is hereby renewed for one year.

The contract term covered by this Amendment is January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024. This is the final contract renewal.


The Fairfax Water Falls Church facility has recently moved to a new location. The Charles Murray Maintenance Facility located at 2930 Industry Lane, Fairfax, VA 22031 hereby replaces the Falls Church location effectively immediately.

Per Section 1.2 Annual Renewals, the Contract Pricing is hereby updated to reflect a 3.3% increase based on relevant CPI-U data from the Bureau of Labor Statistics for the period of Sept 2022 – Sept 2023. The contract pricing is hereby updated to as follows:
