Subject: Addendum # 1 to IFB No. 23-045 Regularly Scheduled Solid Waste and Recycling Pickup and Disposal Services, and As Needed Tire Pickup and Disposal Services

The purpose of this addendum is to revise the Invitation to Bid (IFB) and to answer questions received by the deadline. The sealed bid due date is not changed.

I. Additions and Deletions to the IFB

1. **DELETE** Section 1.2 in its entirety and **REPLACE** with the following language:

1.2 The objective of this Invitation to Bid (IFB) is to award a one-year contract(s), with four 1-year renewal options, to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder or bidders to provide municipal solid waste and recycling services (Part 1), and tire pickup and disposal services (Part 2) as specified and defined herein. Fairfax Water will award a contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder or bidders based on total lowest cost for Part 1, Part 2, or in the aggregate, whichever is in the best interest of FW.

2. **ADD** the following sentences to the end of the paragraph in Section 3.3:

The Contractor shall attach photographic evidence to their invoice for any chargeable violation of the prohibited items policy. The photo shall clearly depict the applicable FW location and the material or other substance that caused the violation inside the Contractor owned equipment. Failure to include photographic evidence with the invoice will result in FW deeming the charges as unauthorized and the invoice will be rejected.

3. **DELETE** Section 4.11 Paragraph A in its entirety and **REPLACE** with the following language:

A. Contract award will be made to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder or bidders based on total lowest cost for Part 1, Part 2, or in the aggregate, whichever is in the best interest of FW.

4. **DELETE** Attachment 1A Bid Submission Form Pricing Sheet in its entirety and **REPLACE** with the attached Addendum No. 1 – REVISED Bid Submission Form.

II. Questions and Answers

1. Question:

“Regarding recycling services, are the recycling materials bagged?”

- a. If the materials are bagged, is Fairfax Water allowing contamination charges to be billed at a pre-determined rate as long as supporting photo and/or video evidence is made available?”

Answer:

Glass and aluminum cans may be bagged; paper and cardboard items are not bagged.

- a. Recyclable materials are comingled in the same waste receptacle. All contamination charges billed to Fairfax Water must be in accordance with Section 3.3 of the solicitation.

See Section I, Item No. 2 of this Amendment for revisions made to the IFB.

2. Question:

“Is it a requirement to bid on both the tires and commercial trash and recycling or is there the option to only bid on the trash and recycling?”

Answer:

No. Bidders may bid on Part 1, Part 2, or both.

See Section I, Item No. 1 of this Amendment for revisions made to the IFB.

3. Question:

“Are the tires whole (in-tact), shredded, etc..? Is there the ability to shred prior to disposal?”

Answer:

The tires are whole. FW does not have the ability to shred prior to disposal.

4. Question:

“Regarding the tire roll-offs, would Fairfax Water be willing to open an account to be directly billed the disposal at the tire and/or disposal facility?”

Answer:

No. All disposal costs are the responsibility of the bidder and must be incorporated into the bidder’s bid price per Section 3.4 of the solicitation.
