Subject: Addendum 1 to IFB 24-268 –On-Call Pavement Restoration Services

The purpose of this addendum is to make revisions to the IFB.

I. Additions, Deletions, Corrections, and Revisions to the IFB

Reference Drawing (ex. A-101) or Spec Section (ex. 00400)	Comment:
Specification Section 01200	Replace in full Attachment No. 10 – Section 01200 with Addendum No. 1 – Revised Attachment No. 10 – Section 01200.
Section 2.1.G.1	Replace in full with: “If FW provides an Emergency notification to proceed between 4:00 PM EST and 11:59 PM EST on a calendar day, the Contractor shall initiate the Work between 7:00 AM – 12:00 PM EST the next calendar day. If FW provides an Emergency notification to proceed between 12:00 AM EST and 4:00PM EST on a calendar day, the Contractor shall initiate the Work the same calendar day, within 8 hours of the Emergency notification to proceed.”
Section 1.2	Remove “which shall require mobilization within two hours of an emergency call”.
Cover Page – Bid Due Date	Bid Due Date is changed to October 22, 2024, Prior to 2:00 PM Local Prevailing Time.

II. Questions. Fairfax Water official responses are provided in *Italics*:

#	Question:	Answer:
1	Is this contract for all of your asphalt/concrete repairs, or just for the emergency work only?	<i>This is for all asphalt/concrete work associated with Fairfax Water Distribution maintenance work. This will include water main break repairs and new service installation in existing roadways.</i>
2	Based on historical data, how many times per year has a contractor been called in for emergency work that required mobilization within 2 hours?	<i>This information has not been tracked in the past. We are estimating it will happen 8 times in a year out of the estimated 900 repairs required.</i>
3	I have made and attached some recommendations on some changes of line items to simplify it for all contractors during bidding and that will also work seamlessly in the field. Please let me know if you have any questions.	<p><i>There are no changes to the Attachment 3 – Pricing Schedule. The execution requirements of the asphalt work are included in Attachment 9, Document 01110, Paragraph 1.02.B and revised Attachment 10, Document 01200, Paragraph 1.04. It should also be noted that in Section 2 Paragraph 2.1.a.4 it indicates the appropriate Bid Item to be used will be provided to the Contractor.</i></p> <p><i>Additionally, there are no changes to the Section 1.25 Bid Bond or Section 1.26 Performance Bond and Payment Bond.</i></p>
